The AA Future Business Owners program is a 5-day immersive, hands-on experience that empowers students to explore entrepreneurship by building their own business ventures from the ground up. Throughout the program, students engage in a structured daily schedule that includes learning key concepts such as the Lean Startup methodology, business model design, and strategies for creating social impact. They then apply these concepts by working in teams to develop and refine their business ideas, conduct daily customer interviews, and receive personalized feedback from instructors and mentors. In addition to gaining technical business knowledge, students strengthen critical soft skills like collaboration, communication, time management, and adaptability.

The program culminates in a final pitch showcase, where teams present their ventures to an audience offering students both a confidencebuilding experience and a standout achievement for college and career advancement.

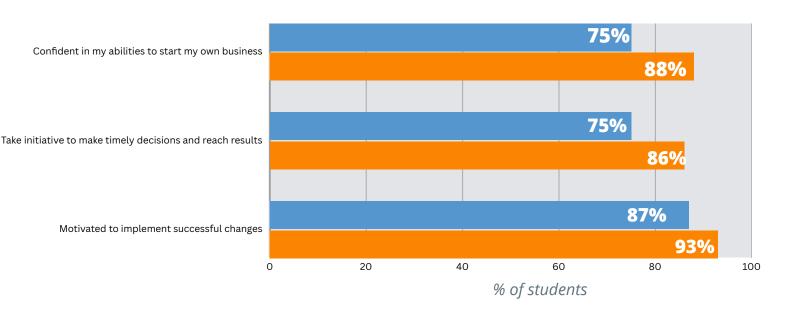
Learning Objectives

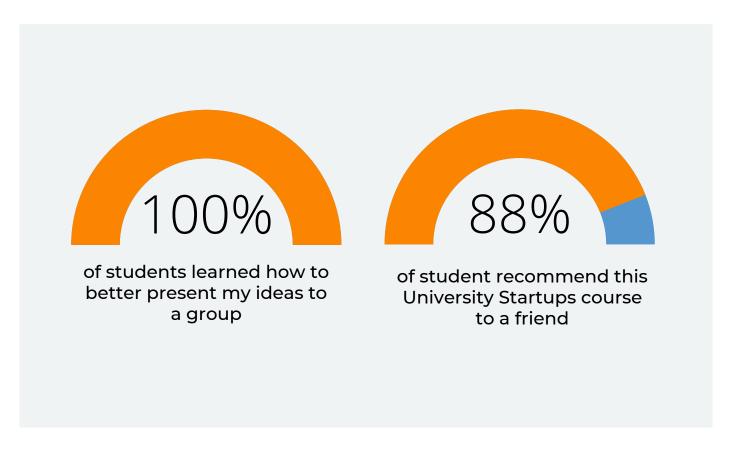
By the end of the program, students:

Change in Mindset

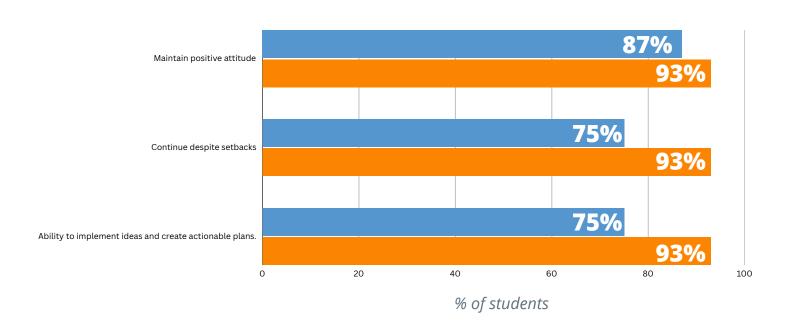
Students improved their understanding of entrepreneurial skills and mindsets.

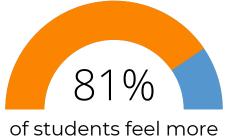

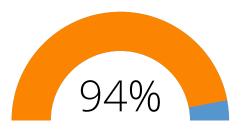

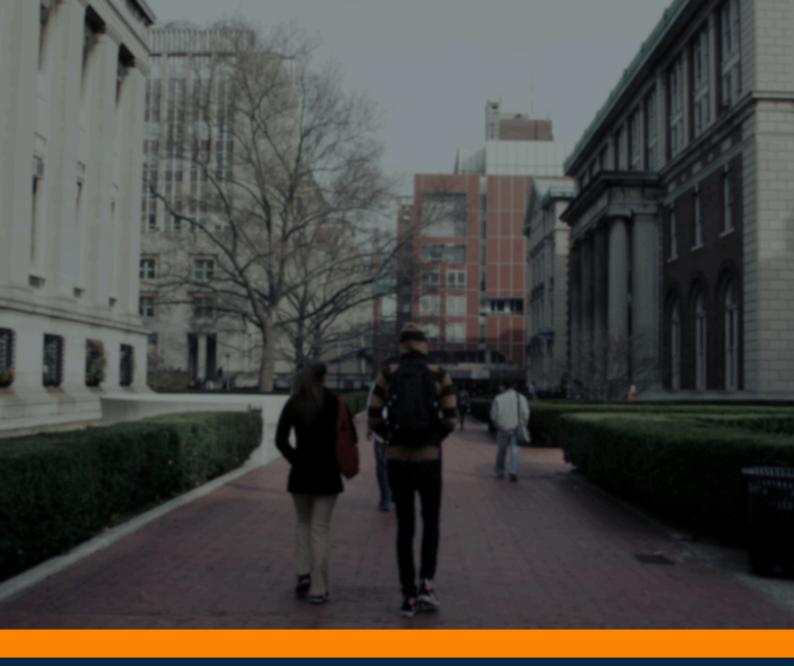
